# Dealing with the Issues of Life

Dear Partner,

I pray this letter finds you experiencing breakthroughs on the right hand and on the left hand.

Sometimes on this journey of faith we can get into a hurry for God to move for us while we are dealing with the issues of this life. The Apostle Paul said in **Philippians 4:11-13** <sup>11</sup> Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content. <sup>12</sup> I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. <sup>13</sup> I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. Like Apostle Paul, I've learned that whatever you ask God for, there is going to be a waiting process. It may be a matter of seconds or years, but we must learn to be content until breakthrough breaks-through. This period of time can either make you or break you depending on how you react to it. The Bible says in **Galatians 6:9** And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, **if we faint not.**

The keys to dealing with the issues of life is to continue to water your seed by walking in love, exercising patience and being strong in the Lord. **This is a three-way combination that the devil can not stop.**

I'll begin with Love. Love is the master key to manifestation. The Bible tells us I **Matthew 22:38** that love is the first and greatest commandment. In **Romans 13:10** it says that love is the fulfilling of the law. **In other words if we embrace love by yielding to the Holy Spirit we can begin to master the waiting process.** Love also serves as a defense against the devils attacks so that we can enjoy the process on the road to manifestation.

The second is patience. Patience is defined as a cheerful endurance. In other words, we must be determined to outlast the challenges. I remember when my wife and I first came to Raleigh, the Lord had given me this huge vision and I saw a huge church with a large mass of people. I saw my family living the life that we had all imagined. I was seeing the end from the beginning, but I had to learn how to enjoy the entire process.

The Bible says in **Philippians 1:6** Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ: Thank God that Jesus is still in the process of performing His Word in every area of our lives.

You see faithfulness is not determined by how we handle mega success. It is determined by how we handle small successes. When you can prove yourself in the least, then God can trust you with much! When you allow success to happen God's way, you will have no choice but to give Him the glory and you will be prepared for every stage of development.

The third area is to remain strong. In **Ephesians 6** it says <sup>10</sup>Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. <sup>11</sup>Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles (trickery) of the devil. **God would have never put to be strong in the Word if we were not capable of being strong. You see every statement in the Bible is written with the power and the blood to back it up!**

It is no surprise to God that you are where you are right now. The truth is that you can outlast any situation and overcome any obstacle that stands in your way. The Bible says in **Romans 8:31** What shall we then say to these things? *(Have you said anything lately?)* If God be for us, who can be against us? The Bible says in **Colossians 2:15** And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it. According to our covenant partner (God) we can deal with ANY situation that comes our way. After all, we are not just conquerors, we are MORE THAN conquerors through Him that Loves us! (**Romans 8:37**)
